What we're about?

The Society of St. Vincent de Paul harnesses the power of community and partnerships to feed, clothe, house and heal individuals and families in our community who have nowhere else to turn for help. As important, SVdP provides meaningful opportunities for volunteers to serve their neighbors in need with love and compassion. Over the last year we've seen a 30% increase in our community's need for food. To meet this need, we intend to raise 1.8 million pounds of non-perishable food through community donation drives. Along with this effort we hope to work with supporters in the legal community and raise 20,000 pounds of food to feed Arizona individuals and families.

The Point System

Teams are awarded points for physical non-perishable food donations, financial contributions and volunteer hours served at St. Vincent de Paul. Each contribution is assigned a point value below.

\$1 = 1 point 1 volunteer hour = 5 points

5 cans = 10 points

Our team will keep track of your online financial donations, hours volunteered and will come weekly to count your canned goods, but we HIGHLY encourage you to track your team's contributions as well.

Remember to motivate your colleagues to reach out to family members and friends to donate and participate in volunteer shifts. The more the merrier!
