

Volunteer Dress Code Policy

For safety reasons, SVdP encourages volunteers to dress appropriately for the conditions and performance of their volunteer assignment. All volunteers are required to adhere to the following guidelines:

- Closed-toed shoes with rubber soles.
- Tops and shirts must have sleeves, and the midriff areas must be covered. No tank tops, tube, or halter tops.
- Shorts/skirts/pants must be knee-length or longer.
- Clothing must be free from profanity, offensive language, or graphic images.

We advise volunteers to wear layered clothing in the winter and light clothing in the summer. We advise farm volunteers to wear long-sleeved shirts and pants due to the nature of the tasks.

Our programs will provide other job-specific clothing/equipment required.

Volunteers are required to sign the SVdP Dress Code policy when they first volunteer with us and annually on April 1st.
