

Opportunities for Volunteers with Court-ordered and Probation Community Service Hour Requirements

The Society of St. Vincent de Paul (SVdP) provides opportunities for individuals who need to complete hours as part of a court or probation requirement to complete volunteer hours with us. However, we do not accept all charges. **Charges we do not accept include, but are not limited to, all forms of assault, violence and sexual offenses.**

Prospective volunteers who wish to complete court-ordered community service and probation hours with SVdP must submit the court-ordered and probation project application. The application will require prospective volunteers to upload **copies of their court/citation documents** so Volunteer Engagement can review their charges.

Once we review the charges, we will assign eligible volunteers to watch the virtual volunteer orientation through our learning management module and complete a test to demonstrate they have completed orientation. Volunteers who pass the quiz will be approved to volunteer with us. Volunteers may retake the quiz as many times as needed to pass the quiz.

We will NOT verify hours for court that are completed BEFORE we review charges and approve candidates to volunteer with us. Additionally, please note there are restrictions on which volunteer areas are open to those completing court-ordered community service and probation hours. We will inform you of the restrictions when we review your charges with you.
